A – Probably fuel degradation high to low pressures or dieseling, probably not electrostatic discharge.

Q – Is cat oil burn systems have a problem with your filters?

A - Media not normally but the oil probably will be as clean as fuels.

Q - Do you offer anything that will coalesce water?

A – Yes we have filters that will absorb water like a diaper but they plug up quickly.

Q – Are people are complaining about plugging of filters due to additive plugging?

A – We are seeing it in the bulk tank but blaming the vehicle filter, due to cold weather separating the additive from the fuel, try to mitigate with bulk filter application.
